A national survey of
Indigenous-language
immersion programs
and schools



- **Why?** To build a national database about these programs to support improved education practice for Native American students.
- **What?** The survey will showcase Native communities' efforts to strengthen their language education through immersion teaching methods. Survey questions ask about demographic information, program goals, key features, and outcomes.
- **How is "immersion" defined?** At least 50% of instructional time is spent in the Indigenous language. Immersion may take place both in and out of school.
